Section-by-Section Analysis

Section 1 Appointment of Districts Judicial Nominating Commissioners

- A simple majority of commissioners shall be of the same gender
- Beginning with terms starting February 1, 2012, each county in the judicial election district must have at least one appointed commissioner on the judicial district nominating committee.
- This legislation should not be used to remove appointed commissioners prior to the end of their term.
