### Section-by-Section Analysis

#### Section I Uniform Interest Date

Money due to the permanent school fund that is not paid is now reported to the school board, not the county attorney.

#### Section II Suit-Attorney Fee

If a debtor to the school does not comply with notice, noncompliance is reported to the school board, not the county attorney, who will then bring action to recover the debt.

#### Section III County Attorney Duties-Advice to Schools

Removes school from list of groups the county attorney must give advice or a written opinion to without compensation.

#### Section IV County Attorney Duties

Strikes the requirement that the county attorney bring legal proceedings to recover school funds.

#### Section V County Attorney Duties

Strikes Chapter 818 and replaces it with 819 and 820, which are similar to chapter 818

#### Section VI Repeal Chapter 818

Repeal chapter 818- Establishing interstate extradition compacts.

#### Section VII Repeal Chapter 819A

Repeals Code chapter 819A- retention of prisoners as witnesses in criminal proceedings.
