### **BOEE License Denial and Revocation**

Requires that the Board of Educational Examiners include in their rules for denial or revocation of a license if the applicant or licensee pled guilty to or are found guilty of enticing a minor, human trafficking, or any other similar offense to the remaining offenses already in code.

---

### **Summary of Action**

The Senate **PASSED** SF 120 on February 23, 2011, by a vote of 48-0.  
The House **PASSED** SF 120 on April 4, 2011, by a vote of 98-0.  
The Governor **SIGNED** SF 120 of April 12, 2011.

---

### **Section by Section Analysis**

**Sections 1 and 2** – These sections amend the rules for determining eligibility for licensure with the Board of Ed Examiners. Section 1 removes language and moves it to Section 2 of the bill.

Section 2 adds reasons for which an applicant for licensure may be denied or the license may be revoked:

- Enticing a minor
  - Human Trafficking
  - Any comparable offense to those listed in the subsection (similar language to what was removed in Section 1)
