### Licensing by DPH and IWD

- Under current law, the labor services division of the department of workforce development and the department of public health (DPH) are directed to combine the contractor registration and contractor licensing application process for those licensed under Code chapter 105 - the Iowa plumber, mechanical professional, and contractor licensing act
- As part of this process, DPH is required to transfer to the labor services division a portion of each contractor license fee equal to three times the current contractor registration fee
- The above mandate is stricken and instead a prorated fee is set which will be determined depending on how long the contractor chooses to register their license for in the state

### Section by Section Analysis

Section 1 – 91C.1 – Definitions – exemption – combined registration and licensing process for plumbers and mechanical professionals:

Strikes language that would mandate DPH transfers to the labor services division a portion of each contractor license fee equal to three times the current contractor registration fee

Adds a new subsection that mandates DPH transfer to the labor services division a portion of each contractor license fee equal to three times the contractor registration fee for each three-year license or a prorated portion of the fees

Section 2 – 91C.2 – Definitions – exemption – combined registration and licensing process for plumbers and mechanical professionals:

Strikes language that mandates \$25,000 surety bonds filed with the division of labor services are filed for a one-year period – there is no longer a timeline period

Section 3 – effective upon enactment
