High School Credit for 8th Graders

Allows for a student who completes a high school class required for high school graduation to receive graduation credit for that class.

Summary of Action

The Senate **PASSED** SF 453 on March 10, 2011, by a vote of 50-0.
The House **PASSED** SF 453, as amended, on April 4, 2011, by a vote of 98-0.
The Senate **CONCURRED** with the House amendment on April 7, 2011, by a vote of 49-1.
The Governor **SIGNED** SF 453 on April 19, 2011.

Section by Section Analysis

Section 1 Modifies the rules for high school graduation requirements to allow for any student who completes a high school class that counts towards graduation requirements to be given credit for that completion.
