### Summary

Senate Version: Makes K2 a schedule I controlled substance.  
House Amendment: Adds K2, Bath Salts and Salvia with increased penalties.

### Summary of Action

### Section-by-Section Analysis

#### Section I

- Salvia divinorum (not the garden variety)
- Salvinornia A
- Any substance that contains synthetic cannabinoids (ie; K2), not approved as a pharmaceutical
- Bath Salts (not what people use for a bath)

#### Section II

- Class "D" felony for manufacturing, delivering, or possession with the internet to manufacture or deliver. A class "D" felon shall be confined for no more than five years, and in addition shall be sentenced to a fine of at least seven hundred fifty dollars but not more than seven thousand five hundred dollars.
- Serious misdemeanor for a first offense possession.
- Serious Misdemeanor is punishable by confinement for no more than one year and a fine of at least \$315 but no more than \$1,875.
