DAS Procedures Concerning Non-Lead Wheel Weights Use on State Vehicles

House File 785 proposes to require the Director of the Iowa Department of Administrative Services to establish procedures encouraging the use of non-lead wheel weights on state vehicles if such alternative wheel weights are readily available. The bill was considered and passed the House Environmental Protection Committee on Monday February 1, 2010, by a somewhat bipartisan 16-aye to 4-nay vote. HF 785's Senate companion (SF 2090) did not pass the first Senate funnel and has died in the Senate Transportation Committee.

Summary of Action

The House Environmental Protection Committee passed HF 785 on Monday February 1, 2010, by a somewhat bipartisan 16-aye to 4-nay vote.

Section by Section Analysis

Sections 1 – DAS to Establish Procedures for Non-Lead Wheel Weights on State Vehicles This section proposes to require the Director of the Iowa Department of Administrative Services to establish procedures encouraging the use of non-lead wheel weights on state vehicles if such alternative wheel weights are readily available.
